Connecting to AUE Library Resources in Google Scholar



HOW CAN I CONNECT GOOGLE SCHOLAR TO AUE LIBRARY'S RESOURCES?

Follow these steps to link Google Scholar to AUE Library's electronic collections.

1. Go to Google Scholar and select Settings under the menu:



2. Click Library links then search for "American University in the Emirates" Select American University in the Emirates – Full-Text @ AUE Library and then click Save:
